**Subject: Information Sessions on LIFE+ 2010**

Dear Sir or Madam,

I have pleasure in inviting you to a European Commission Information Session on the LIFE+ Programme. The Information Session will be held on **Thursday 27<sup>th</sup> May 2010** at the **Warszawski Dom Technika NOT, Warsaw**, and will be conducted in Polish.

The aims of this Session are to: inform potential applicants about the LIFE+ Programme in the context of the 2010 Call for Proposals; help potential applicants decide whether or not to submit a LIFE+ proposal; and highlight some key issues to help avoid common problems in submitting a proposal. The target audience is therefore those who:

- Have little or no knowledge of the LIFE+ Programme;
- Are submitting their first proposal; or who
- Have submitted an unsuccessful proposal in the past.

However, those with previous LIFE experience are also welcome to attend.

Please note that no information will be available about the ongoing selection process from the 2009 LIFE+ Call for Proposals. Furthermore, this is an Information Session and not a “Writers’ Workshop” and therefore will not provide in-depth working groups on preparing proposals.
